Minor requires General Biology (01:119:115, 01:119:116 & 01:119:117 or 01:119:101 & 01:119:102) and 4 elective courses of at least 3 credits each in life sciences subjects. At least three of the required courses must be taken at Rutgers-New Brunswick. A maximum of 3 credits of Research in Biology may be used toward the minor. ***A minimum of three courses at the 300 level or above is required.** Only life sciences courses acceptable for the biological sciences major may be used for the minor. Courses in chemistry, mathematics, or physics do not count toward the minor. A grade-point average of 2.0 or better in courses credited toward the minor is required. Maximum of one course with a grade of "D". No more than 2 of the 4 electives applied toward the Biology minor may be courses also used to fulfill a student's major requirements.
