A maximum of 3 credits of Research in Biology may be used toward the minor. *A minimum of three courses at the 300 level or above is required. Only life sciences courses acceptable for the biological sciences major may be used for the minor. Courses in chemistry, mathematics, or physics do not count toward the minor. A grade-point average of 2.0 or better in courses credited toward the minor is required. Maximum of one course with a grade of "D". No more than 2 of the 4 electives applied toward the Biology minor may be courses also used to fulfill a student's major requirements.
