This class is offered both in person and online. Which section is best for you?

Q: Will the online class be harder?

A: The content covered, workload, and difficulty level will be the SAME between the online and in-person sections of this course. Students in both sections will be learning the same content at the same time and are encouraged to study together if possible!

Q: What will a typical week look like in the online course?

A: Mondays and Thursdays, students must attend a 1-hour zoom session from 11:00am-12:00pm. These zoom sessions will be structured like recitations, not lectures, and active participation in Zoom polls is expected. Prior to these sessions, students should listen and take notes on the two mini lectures assigned for that day (~25-40 minutes each). A low-stakes concept check quiz is due every Mon/Thurs evening at 11:59pm. On Sundays, a harder, higher-stakes cumulative weekly quiz is due at 11:59pm.

Q: What will a typical week look like in the in-person course?

A: Mondays and Thursdays, lecture runs from 9:00am-10:20am on the Livingston Campus (BRR-1095). The first half of class will be lecture and the second half structured like a recitation, with active participation expected. Identical to the online course, a low-stakes concept check quiz is due every Mon/Thurs evening at 11:59pm. On Sundays, a harder, higher-stakes cumulative weekly quiz is due at 11:59pm.

Q: Will there be office hours?

A: ALL students, regardless of which section they are in, will have 4 office hours available to them: Mondays and Thursdays from 1-2pm on campus (Room TBA), and Tuesday and Fridays from 11am-12pm on Zoom. A limited number of individual appointments will be available each week as well.
